KYRUGI

****MANUAL SCORING ONLY****

It is the responsibility of all players and coaches to provide protective equipment. This will not be provided by the organisers.

Competitors must be ready with kit on when called to the mat.

Kyorugi head guard in red/blue in line with body protective colour. Body protector, arm guards, shin guards, groin guard must be from approved supplier. Gum shield must be clear or white. Arm and shin guards must be worn under dobok.

Traditional Dobok or Gi must be worn.

No jewellery or footwear can be worn. Plasters will be acceptable to cover jewellery that cannot be removed.

All bandages/supports must be cleared by the organiser.

Coaches must wear tracksuit or smart casual – doboks will not be acceptable.

Paramedics will be in attendance.

Child/Cadet : 2 rounds x 2-minute rounds

Junior and Senior: 2 rounds x 2-minute rounds

Veteran : 2 rounds x 2-minute rounds

ALL FINALS: 3 x 2 minute rounds

POOMSAE

Traditional dobok/poomsae dobok/ITF doboks only. No coloured or non taekwondo dobok

Kup Grades must wear all white dobok. Poom grades may wear poom black and red collar dobok.

No jewellery or footwear. Plasters are acceptable to cover any jewellery which cannot be removed.

Bandages/supports must be cleared by the organiser.

Patterns:

5th to 9th Kup 2 patterns per round and patterns can be repeated.

4th to 2nd Kup 2 patterns from pattern 3/Sam Jang and above. Patterns cannot be repeated

1st Kup and Dan 2 patterns from pattern 6/Yuk Jang and above. Patterns cannot be repeated

All players must announce their pattern on the mat

Para divisions will be available and will be announced closer to the date.

Maximum 2 coaches per club and only one coach at side of mat with competitor. Coaches should wear tracksuit top or casual. Doboks will not be accepted.

Judges must wear black or grey trousers, white shirt, WUMF association/national/international tie and white trainers/taekwondo approved shoes.

TRAVEL

The K2 Leisure Centre is on the A23 at Pease Pottage Hill in Tilgate, between Thomas Bennett School and Tilgate Forest Recreation Centre, and opposite Broadfield Stadium.

Arriving by Bus or Train: The K2 Leisure Centre is a little over one mile from Crawley railway station. To walk to the leisure centre, turn right out of the station, then right again at the traffic lights onto Southgate Avenue. At the end of Southgate Avenue, turn left. The leisure centre is about 200 yards ahead of you on the left-hand side of the A23. The number 2 bus between Tilgate, the town centre and Ifield visits the K2 Leisure Centre approximately every 15 minutes. The number 10 Fastway bus stops nearby, at Broadfield Stadium and on Southgate Avenue.

Arriving by Car From the south: Follow the A23 towards Crawley. About one mile past Pease Pottage, get in the outside lane and turn right at the traffic lights. Watch out for the 50 mph limit as you approach the lights — there are sometimes speed trap

From the north: Follow the A23 through Crawley. Look for a roundabout containing a giant football, outside Broadfield Stadium. Go straight on in the left-hand lane, and very soon you will see the K2 Leisure Centre to your left as you approach a set of traffic lights.

From the M23: Leave the motorway at junction 11, Pease Pottage. Get in the right-hand lane on the slip road, follow the roundabout all the way round and join the A23 heading towards Crawley. The K2 Leisure Centre is a little over one mile along on your right, at the first set of traffic lights.

Free car parking, including disabled bays close to the main entrance, is available but usually fills up early when the K2 Leisure Centre is hosting toy or wedding fairs. Other locations nearby are often used as overflow car parks, and will be signposted when in use
